COVER LETTER TO VICAR/PIC/DEAN'S ENDORSEMENT FOR AN APPLICATION TO REGISTER FOR PRIMARY ONE IN AN ANGLICAN SCHOOL UNDER PHASE 2B

Dear Parent/s,

I am Revd. Dr. Joshua Sudharman, Chairman of the Education Board of the Diocese of Singapore. I represent the Bishop of Singapore in matters pertaining to our Anglican schools.

Please allow me to explain the purpose of the captioned form and the criteria that schools will apply in determining if your application to register your child in an Anglican school under Phase 2B will be accepted.

The form is to establish that at least one parent is a bona fide member of an Anglican parish and demonstrates active commitment to the church community. This criterion of demonstrable commitment is necessary as Phase 2B of the P1 registration process consists of 3 sub-groups, as spelt out in the MOE website:

- a. For a child whose parent is a parent volunteer at the school, starting before 1 July 2021 and completing at least 40 hours of service by 30 June 2022.
- b. For a child whose parent is a member endorsed by the church or clan directly connected to the school.
- c. For a child whose parent is endorsed as an active community leader.

Categories (a) and (c) both require demonstrable commitment, and therefore so must category (b).

The form requires Vicars/Priests-in-Charge(PICs)/Deans to answer 4 questions pertaining to the parents' membership, attendance, service and care group involvement, and to answer 'Yes' for each parent with a church stamp.

The objective criteria we are using for endorsement (which we have modified from previous years due to the disruptions caused by Covid-19) are that either the father should receive a stamp for the first question and one additional stamp, or the mother should receive a stamp for the first question and one additional stamp.

If these criteria are met, and the Vicar/PIC/Dean endorses the application with his signature, the form will be accepted by the school without requiring any further comments by the Vicar/PIC/Dean.

However we do realize that some may narrowly miss out on the minimum of 2 stamps because of circumstances beyond their control. In such a situation, the church is prepared

to make some concessions. Nevertheless we cannot do away with all objectivity and fairness while making these concessions.

So in cases where a parent is <u>only able to get the stamp for the first question</u>, and there are factors beyond the parent's control why getting a 2nd stamp was not possible, the Vicar/PIC/Dean may have the discretion to write an explanatory note in the box provided <u>in lieu of the 2nd stamp</u> to meet the criteria, and endorse the application with his signature. Such a form will still be accepted by the school, i.e. a form endorsed by the Vicar/PIC/Dean containing a stamp for the first question, <u>AND</u> an <u>explanation from the Vicar/PIC/Dean in lieu of a 2nd stamp for that same parent</u>. (See Appendix for outcomes of various permutations.)

In cases where a parent has not been able to get a stamp for the first question, the application will not be accepted by the schools as it falls too far short of the criteria. Vicars/PICs/Deans have been advised not to endorse such applications, and even if some Vicars/PICs/Deans do (out of kindness) endorse such a form, the schools have been instructed not to accept them.

We know this may come as a disappointment to those whose applications are not accepted, but we need to do our best to hold in tension the need for objectivity and fairness in the process on one hand, and the need for grace on the other.

Above all, we pray that God Almighty, for whom nothing is too difficult, will bless and prosper the education of your children, whichever schools they are in.
