PALM SUNDAY 2025 | GOD MOVES TO THE CROSS Luke 23:26-49

INTRODUCTION:

Take time to read Luke 23:26-49.

- What stood out to you from the passage?
- Are there any questions you have from reading the passage?

DISCUSS:

1. Considering the events of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on the first Palm Sunday (Luke 19:28-38), why would the events on the first Good Friday (our passage in Luke 23:26-49) have taken Jesus' followers by surprise?

2. How does Jesus show His kingship in the events described in Luke 23:26-49? (See vv34, 38)

3. As Jesus goes to His death, how do we see His humility and focus on the will of the Father and the needs of others?

4. How does this passage encourage us to take heart that when things in our lives seem to be at their lowest point, God is still close to us and at work?

PRAY:

- What practical step can you take in response to the truth you find in this passage?
- Is there a low point in your life right now where you feel far from God? Pray and ask how God is still at work, trusting that He is closer than you realise.
